COGHSTA MEC VISIT ALTOOSTYD (JOE SLOVO) AND MARAPONG CRU

Limpopo MEC for Cooperative Governance, Human Settlement and Traditional Affairs, Basikopo Makamu, visited Lephalale Local Municipality on 23 September 2019 to track progress of major projects in the area as part of a build up towards his

100 days in office.

MEC Makamu who was accompanied by the Local Mayor, Councillor Moloko Jack Maeko, Councillors, Representatives from local traditional authority (Kgoshi PD Seleka and Kgoshi RJ Shongoane) and other relevant stakeholders embarked on a site visit to check progress on both multi-million rands projects of Altoostyd - Lephalale Integrated Human Settlements Project (IHSP) which is geared to deliver 5575 human settlements units and Marapong Community Residential Units (CRU) project which has secured a target of 514 residential units.

The Marapong project which is the first of its kind in Lephalale is expected to be completed next year. These projects are part of the government's renewed commitment and constitutional stipulation in ensuring that it reduces backlog and provide quality human settlements to beneficiaries.

In concluding the meeting the MEC held a meeting with all relevant stakeholders at the project sites to discuss progress, challenges and solutions to issues which were identified as hindrances towards the completion of the projects.
