SOD-TURNING CEREMONY FOR MARAPONG SPORTS, ART, AND CULTURE PRECINCT

As part of accelerating development, Lephalale Local Municipality Mayor, Cllr Moloko Jack Maeko, hosted Limpopo MEC for Sports, Arts and Culture, Thandi Moraka, MEC for Education, Polly Boshielo and Waterberg District Executive Mayor, Cllr Morris Mataboge at the sod-turning ceremony of the Marapong Sports, Arts and Culture Precinct on 10 May 2021.

The Precinct is aimed at providing the community of Marapong with a safe and interactive recreation facility to amongst other things, nature the interest of the youth in sport and the community at large. Exxaro Mine in partnership with the Local Municipality and the Provincial Department of Sports, Arts and Culture will upgrade the existing infrastructure and add applicable equipment, facilities, and amenities for the Centre to be utilized as Sports, Arts and Recreational facility.
