OFFICIAL HANDOVER OF REAR-END LOADER COMPACTOR TRUCK

As part of Exxaro Grootegeluk Mine 2018 Social Labour Plan (SLP), the mine handed over a Rear-end Loader Compactor Truck to Lephalale Local Municipality. The truck which was received by the Mayor of Lephalale Local Municipality, Cllr Aron Mokgetle will assist in accelerating waste removal services within the Municipality.

In his acceptance remarks, the Mayor started by appreciating the good working relationship between the mine's Executive Head Stakeholder Affairs and Investor Relations, Mr Mzila Mthenjane and his team. "It is through the good working relationship we have with the mine's officials, that today we are receiving this truck which will assist the Municipality to improve the collection of waste effectively," said the Mayor. The truck brings to eight, the number of waste trucks servicing Lephalale Town, Onverwacht and Marapong.
