ELECTION OF WARD COMMITTEES' MEMBERS TO SERVE ON WARD COMMITTEES IN THEIR RESPECTIVE WARDS FOR THE TERM 2021 – 2026

Notice is hereby given that in terms of Section 19 of the Municipal Structures Act read with Chapter 4 of the Municipal Systems Act, that Lephalale Local Municipality herewith invites residents to participate in the election of Ward Committee members for the fifteen (15) Wards Committees in the Municipal areas as indicated hereunder. Ten (10) Ward Committee Members to be elected per ward.

It is the intent of Lephalale Municipality Council that all Ward Committees must reflect the composition, geographic spread as well as sectoral composition of each ward (where applicable) in order to serve as a representative on the following portfolios:

Education & Early Childhood Development
Planning & Economic Development
Health & Social Development,
Housing/Human Settlement
Training & Skills Development
Home Affairs
Local Economic Development
Land & Agriculture
Sports, Arts & Culture
Parks, Cemeteries & waste management
Community Safety and Security
Tourism & Environment

REQUIREMENTS TO SERVE ON WARD COMMITTEES

The following election criteria may be applied for electing ward committee members:

- To be elected as a member of a ward committee, a person must be a registered voter in the ward.
- A person is not eligible for election if he or she works for the local municipality or the district municipality within which the local municipality is demarcated. A person must be permanently or contractually employed by the municipality.
- A person should not be in arrears to the municipality for rates and service charges for a period longer than three months.
- A person must be able to read and write.
- A person should not be an unrehabilitated insolvent.

- Persons of unsound mind who have been declared so by a competent court cannot be elected.
- Members should be active in the sector or geographic area they represent and should be motivated to work on the ward committee by their commitment to working for a better life for their constituency.
- The Public is requested to bring their Identity Documents (ID's).
- Covid 19 regulations will be followed.

Kindly note that the Election of Ward Committee Members will be held on the date and times stipulated below at the following venues for the fifteen (15) Wards in the Lephalale Municipality Area of jurisdiction.
