### **POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE AT LEPHALALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY**

A staff member at Lephalale Local Municipality has tested positive for Covid-19 on the 08<sup>th</sup> July 2020. It has been noted that the last time the employee was at work was on the 26<sup>th</sup> June 2020. The Municipality is taking precautionary measures to ensure safety of all employees and the public by temporarily closing the offices from the 10<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and will reopen on Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

The affected staff member is currently in self-isolation and the Municipality is following all the necessary precautionary measures as outlined by the National Department of Health.

The Municipal building will be disinfected during the temporary closure to ensure the safe return of staff members and the public on Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

The provision of the following essential services will remain uninterrupted:

- Water
- Sanitation
- Electricity
- Refuse removal

Employees and members of the public are urged to observe the health and hygiene protocols and adhere to all the regulations of Covid-19 in order to curb the spread of the virus.

The Municipality wishes the affected staff member a speedy recovery and discourages the stigmatisation of people who are infected as this virus is a global challenge.
