#### **Minimum Requirements for the Bursary Funding.**

- Eligible Learners must be residents of Lephalale Local Municipality.
- Tertiary students must attach their CVs and shortlisted candidates will undergo compulsory Psychometric assessments and interviews.
- Learners must show consistent good academic performance.
- Their parents must be unemployed or classified as indigent.
- Bursary will cover the following: Tuition fees, accommodation and meals. (Prescribed books will be provided to most needy students only).
- Mean test will be conducted by visiting the home of the applicants to determine the need of the concerned applicant.
- Awarding of bursary will be sealed after receiving proof of tertiary acceptance letter and admission to study.
- Learners to study in the following study fields:
  - a) Financial Studies,
  - b) Civil, Electrical & Mechanical & Chemical Engineering,
  - c) Town and Regional Planning.
