INTRODUCTION OF MARAPONG ACCESS ROAD CONTRACTORS

On 31 July 2025, the Mayor of Lephalale Local Municipality, Councillor Aaron Mokgetle, accompanied by municipal councillors and officials, officially introduced two significant access road projects in Marapong township.

These road infrastructure developments form part of the municipality's ongoing commitment to improving service delivery and enhancing the quality of life for residents within the community. The first project involves the rehabilitation of Relebogile Street, covering a distance of 700 meters. The scope of work includes the removal of the existing top surface, preparation of the underlying layer, and resurfacing with asphalt. This project is scheduled to be completed within three months and is expected to create temporary employment opportunities for 14 workers.

The second project entails the construction of Ben Matsoma Street, spanning 525 meters. This new road will feature 80mm paving blocks, the installation of V drains to improve stormwater management, as well as road signage, markings, and speed humps to ensure safety and traffic regulation. Mayor Mokgetle underscored the importance of delivering high-quality workmanship and adhering to the project timelines to ensure these infrastructure improvements meet the expectations of the Marapong community. These initiatives reflect the municipality's dedication to fostering sustainable development and improving access within the township.

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
