LEPHALALE SCHOOL PROJECT ENGAGEMENT SESSION

Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya, the Limpopo Education MEC, along with the Mayor of Lephalale Local Municipality, Cllr Aaron Mokgetle and the acting Mayor of Modimolle-Mookgopong Local Municipality, Cllr Anna Mboweni, headed a group that included senior managers from Lephalale and Modimolle-Mookgophong municipalities, infrastructure teams, and the curriculum team from the education department to Future Nation Schools, Fleurhof Campus, in Soweto on 04 April 2025.

These schools are part of an initiative by Eskom Foundation. Among other initiatives, the foundation offers substantial assistance through infrastructure development in rural schools to tackle the disparities in the provision of quality education in South Africa. This encompasses, among other aspects, the establishment of classrooms, libraries, sports fields, and additional facilities that significantly enhance the education offered by under-resourced schools in South Africa.

The purpose of the visit was to understand effective practices regarding the schools model. Mr. Sizwe Nxasana, the CEO of Future Nation Schools, led a site visit to the building and structure of the Future Nations school facilities donated by the Foundation in Diepkloof. The Foundation intends to establish similar infrastructure in Lephalale.

Limpopo Department of Education, together with external partners, intends to construct similar cutting-edge environmental schools in Mookgophong and Lephalale, located in the Waterberg District. The establishment of adequate and respectable infrastructure continues to be a central focus for the 7th Administration
