MISSION: SERVICE DELIVERY-JULY

In July, several municipal service delivery departments in Lephalale actively undertook various essential maintenance and repair operations to enhance community infrastructure and public amenities.

The Public Works Department focused on tree trimming along Clubhouse Street to ensure safe and unobstructed thoroughfares. Concurrently, the Maintenance Team addressed sewer line blockages on Chris Hani Avenue to restore proper drainage. The Municipal Water Services team successfully repaired a leaking pipe at the intersection of J Louis Botha and Pika Streets, preventing water wastage and potential damage to adjacent properties. The Municipal Sanitation Department resolved a significant sewer line blockage on Joe Slovo Street, near KFC and BUCO, caused by grease accumulation, utilizing a high-pressure jetting machine, the team efficiently cleared the obstruction.

Additionally, they conducted ongoing repair work at Pump Station 16, located within the Shoprite parking area on Hendrik Street, addressing infrastructure challenges to improve sewage management. In Extension 2 of Marapong Township, the sanitation team also removed sand deposits clogging a sewer line. Due to the complexity of the repairs at Pump Station 16, the sanitation crew remained stationed on-site, diligently working to complete the necessary restoration.

The Parks Department undertook landscaping and maintenance activities, including cleaning and trimming trees on Clubhouse Street, mowing grass at the corner of Nelson Mandela Street and the landfill area, and tidying Sandsteen Park to enhance the community's recreational spaces. These coordinated efforts reflect the Municipality's commitment to providing efficient and effective service delivery to the residents of Lephalale.
