PROVINCIAL OVERSIGHT VISIT TO GROBLERSBRIDGE AND MARTIN'S DRIFT BOARDER POSTS FOLLOWING THE RECENT DISASTROUS FLOODS

Limpopo MEC for Treasury, Mr Kgabo Mahoai, and the Mayor of Lephalale Local Municipality, Cllr Aaron Mokgetle joined by the Local Disaster Management Team, have today conducted an oversight visit to the Groblersbridge Border Post. The visit is part of the Limpopo Provincial Government Oversight Visit to floods affected Areas in Lephalale.

The entourage took a walk-about at the Groblersbridge Port of Entry, to assess the extend of the damages caused by the recent heavy rains and floods.

The Port of Entry has been closed since the 14 of January 2025.

The entourage is joined by the Speaker of Council, Cllr Grace Marakalala, EXCO Member, Cllr Ratah Modiba, Limpopo Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA) Disaster Team, Boarder Management Authority (BMA), SAPS, and other officials.

The entourage concluded the programme by visiting the Martin's Drift Boarder Post that connects South Africa and Botswana.
