Lephalale Local Municipality Council alongside the three local traditional authorities welcomed the presentation by investors on renewable energy. The presentation which was held at the Municipal council chamber on 18 February was to forge new working relationships within the Municipal boarders.

The innovative solar power plant will assist the municipality by reducing the load from the electricity grid, by providing residents of Lephalale with sufficient electricity. This initiative is viewed as a crucial step in the right direction towards solving energy challenges for future generations, shaping strategies and connecting sustainable efforts by improving development that works towards these challenges.

In his remarks the Mayor of Lephalale Local Municipality, Cllr Aaron Mokgetle, put a strong emphasis on projects that are transformative in addressing the challenges within the municipality, saying that all projects that aligns with solving the challenges of the Municipality and enhancing service delivery, will always be welcomed with open arms.

The solar power plant which will be situated between Lephalale town and Marapong will consist of 315 MW.

One thing that both the councils collectively agreed on was that the implementation of the project will also assist to ease up on the issues of unemployment currently experienced in Lephalale.
