INTRODUCTION OF CONTRACTOR FOR LETLORA ACCESS ROAD PROJECT

On 21 AUGUST 2025, the Mayor of Lephalale Local Municipality, Councillor Aaron Mokgetle, officially introduced the appointed contractor entrusted with the construction of the Letlora Access Road. This significant project will upgrade the existing 2.4-kilometre gravel road in Letlora Village to a tarred asphalt surface, enhancing accessibility and transportation within the community.

The comprehensive scope of work includes the installation of a properly engineered drainage system (V-drains), the erection of road signage, and the construction of speed humps to ensure the safety of all road users. The project is anticipated to take approximately eight months to complete.

In addition to infrastructure improvement, this development will create fifteen temporary employment opportunities, providing valuable income and skill development for local residents. Furthermore, the project offers a unique practical learning platform for civil engineering students who will gain firsthand experience through direct involvement on-site.

This initiative reaffirms the Municipality's steadfast commitment to delivering quality services and upgrading road infrastructure for the benefit of its communities.

The Mayor's was accompanied by the Speaker of Council, Councillor Grace Marakalala, alongside EXCO Members Councillors Ratah Modiba and Louisa Shongwe, as well as Councillors Kgomotso Bopape, Thapelo Langa, and Linda Mosupye.

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
