MAYOR WELCOMES AMBULANCES IN LEPHALALE

As part of government's effort to improve health services Lephalale Local Municipality Mayor, Cllr Aaron Mokgetle, accompanied by Cllr Thabitha Modise and Joel Madibana officially welcomed 11 new ambulances at the Ellisras Hospital.

The delegation led by Dr Lebogo, conducted a walkabout to inspect the fleet, which consists of planned patient transport, obstetrics and gynaecology which includes an incubator, and normal ambulances which will service community of Lephalale.

The Mayor said that the municipality welcomes any contribution that will accelerate service to the community.

“I am also glad that each crew will receive their own ambulance which will fast-track emergency response to the community, by saving lives and ensuring accountability and collective responsibility for any loss of equipment from the ambulances, and its maintenance.”

The 11 ambulances forms part of the of the Department of Health's procurement of 566 new ambulances pledged to the people of Limpopo, marking a significant milestone in the 30 years since our democratic dawn, showcasing the department's steadfast commitment to enhancing healthcare services throughout the province.
